## Key Products



### FLOOR POLISH STRIPPER

Easily removes old polish prior to re-treatment. Fast acting, low foaming formulation.

Suitable for all types of hard floors



### FLOOR POLISH

Simple to apply polish which gives a high gloss, hard wearing finish that is scuff and slip resistant.



### FLOOR CLEANER & MAINTAINER

Dual action cleaner and floor polish which is suitable for damp mopping, machine cleaning and burnishing. Maintains a slip resistant surface.



### FLOOR CLEANER

Specially designed for use in combination scrubber dryers.

Low foam, unperfumed formulation suitable for use on all types of floor.



### FLOOR GEL LEMON

Easily removes light soiling and provides a slip resistant finish when burnished. Suitable for all hard floor types and leaves a fresh lemon scent.



### CARPET CLEANER

For effective removal of dirt and stains. Low foaming formulation suitable for colourfast and water resistant fabrics.

## Stripping & Polishing Hard Floors: Floor Polish Stripping

- 1) Dilute H23 Floor Polish Stripper at 800ml per 5 litres of warm water in a bucket.
- 2) Apply the solution to the section of floor being treated and leave for 5 minutes. NOTE: Do not allow the solution to dry out.
- 3) Agitate with a mop or scrub with a floor machine fitted with a stripping pad.
- 4) Remove any slurry with either a mop or wet pickup. Once all slurry is removed, rinse the area thoroughly with clean water. The floor must be completely dry before applying fresh polish.

## Polishing

- 1) H24 Floor Polish should be used neat, as supplied.
- 2) Ensure that the floor is clean, dry and free from dirt or dust.
- 3) Apply two thin coats of polish using a clean mop or other applicator. In areas of high traffic or on old worn floors, a third coat may be required.

**NOTE: Use H25 Floor Cleaner & Maintainer regularly to extend the period between stripping**
